Q1 Read the following excerpt and answer all questions that follow.

Since July, there are 114 cases of baby dumping have been reported and the number is still increasing by now. It is getting crucial and steps should be taken earlier before this issue becomes worst.

"The cabinet has decided that the Home Ministry through the police, investigate these cases as murder when a baby dies."

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil, on her ministry's proposal to the cabinet. She said the cabinet agreed that drastic steps had to be taken to stop baby dumping.

Police will be asked to investigate, under Section 302 of the Penal Code, abandoned babies which have died. Under Section 302, the punishment for murder is death. Currently, baby dumping is investigated under other sections or under the Child Act for Abandonments, concealment of birth by secret disposal of body, and infanticide, which stipulate jail terms and fines upon conviction.
